LIFETIME WARRANTY

1. INTRODUCTION

This vehicle was built by highly-skilled craftsmen, from the finest quality materials. So confident are we in the quality of workmanship and materials that your vehicle carries a warranty for as long as you own it.

2. DEFINITIONS

2.1 THE OWNER:

The person who has purchased the vehicle new from the Dealer and whose name and address appears in the acceptance certificate. Where the purchaser is a Company or Partnership, for the purposes of clause 3.2 the term 'Owner' will be deemed to refer to the Director, Partner, or Employee who will normally have use of the vehicle.

2.2 THE DEALER:

The Dealer in motor vehicles who has entered into a distribution and service agreement for the vehicle with DISTRIBUTOR

2.3 THE VEHICLE:

The product which is described in the acceptance certificate.

2.4 THE WARRANTY:

Shall, where the context so permits, include the maintenance program.

2.5 MAJOR OR ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS:

Major or essential components which are necessary for the vehicle to fulfil its normal functions.

2.6 DISTRIBUTOR:

Sole factory licensee, importer and national distributor of the vehicles.

3. THE WARRANTY

3.1 PARTS AND COSTS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

The Warranty covers the cost of repairs or replacement, including parts and labour, of all defective or failed mechanical components in the vehicle which have been produced by original manufacturer, excluding the components listed under the exclusions referred to in section 5.

3.2 PERIOD OF THE WARRANTY

The Warranty will commence on the date of delivery of the vehicle and will endure for an indefinite period. The Warranty will automatically lapse upon the happening of any of the following events:

3.2.1 De-registration

3.2.2 If the vehicle is sold or disposed of to any third party or in the event of the purchaser of the vehicle being a Company, if the Owner ceases for whatever reason to be the person who normally has use of the vehicle

3.2.3 If the vehicle is misused or operated in a negligent manner, or in a manner contrary to the manufacturers or DISTRIBUTOR'S recommendations;

3.2.4 If the vehicle is not serviced and maintained by the Dealer only, strictly in accordance with the maintenance programme and/or DISTRIBUTOR'S recommendations;

3.2.5 If the vehicle is modified, tampered with, or fitted with any non-original part or accessory, without the express agreement of DISTRIBUTOR;

3.2.6 If the vehicle is involved in any accident or collision, or damaged by fire or any other hazard or by the wilful or negligent act of any party whomsoever;

3.2.7 If payment for servicing and maintenance, under the maintenance program, is not made within 30 days of date of invoice or strictly in accordance with terms specified by DISTRIBUTOR from time to time;

3.2.8 If the Owner fails for whatever reason to fulfil their obligations in terms of the maintenance program.

3.3 FAILURE OR BREAKDOWN OF COMPONENTS

In the event of break-down or failure of major or essential components such components will be repaired or replaced by DISTRIBUTOR in terms of the Warranty, as and when such break-down or failure occurs. The repair or replacement of minor or non-essential components and any minor or non-essential adjustments will be carried out at the three-monthly/5000km services referred to in 4.2. Any non-essential adjustments, at any time other than the above services will be charged for at the Dealers normal rates.

4. THE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

4.1 COSTS COVERED BY THE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

The maintenance program covers the entire costs of maintaining and servicing the vehicle in accordance with the maintenance schedule, including all parts, lubricants and labour.

4.2 THE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

4.2.1 The Owner agrees to deliver the vehicle to the Dealer to be serviced/checked every three months or 5000km, whichever occurs first, or such other interval or distance as may be determined by DISTRIBUTOR from time to time.

4.2.2 The Owner will be deemed to have complied with the provision of 4.2.1 if the vehicle is delivered to the Dealer within seven days or 500 km of the above service interval or distance travelled, as the case may be.

4.3 MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS BY OTHER SERVICE PROVIDERS

Should maintenance, servicing or repairs be required at any service provider other than the Dealer, for any reason whatsoever, DISTRIBUTOR must be notified prior to any work being carried out. If any work is carried out by any such other service provider, without DISTRIBUTOR'S written consent, the Warranty will automatically lapse

4.4 COST OF THE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

4.4.1 The Owner will be charged for servicing at the rate of.....cents per kilometre travelled, for the first twelve-month period, and at a rate of.....cents per kilometre for the second twelve-month period. Thereafter, the rate will be adjusted annually in proportion to the increase in Consumer Price Index, for parts and labour.

4.4.2 DISTRIBUTOR shall have the right, forthwith, to terminate the Warranty if the speedometer / distance recorder of the vehicle has, in the opinion of DISTRIBUTOR, been tampered with, disconnected, interfered with in any manner, or has ceased to function correctly and the owner has failed, forthwith, to advise DISTRIBUTOR thereof;

4.4.3 Should the distance recorder fail to operate accurately or at all, for any reason whatsoever, during

any service interval, DISTRIBUTOR shall have the right to estimate the distance travelled by the vehicle during any such service interval, for the purpose of clause 4.4.1.

4.4.4. Service charges in terms hereof shall become due and payable, direct to DISTRIBUTOR, every 10,000 kilometres in advance, prior to maintenance work being carried out. Only upon presentation of receipt can Dealer be authorised to perform service.

5. EXCLUSIONS FROM WARRANTY AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAMME

The following components are excluded from the Warranty and the costs covered by the maintenance programme:

5.1 Oil, water and fuel additives

5.2 Electrical and electronic components

5.3 The following component replacement before completion of normal service intervals (turbo-chargers, tyres, clutch, exhaust - 40 000 km, brakes - 20 000 km, wheel balance - 10,000 km).

5.4 Tyres which would legally be classified as "roadworthy"

5.5 Body components and trim.

5.6 Failure or damage caused by road hazard, corrosion, accident, fire and other perils, negligence, misuse, racing or competition, or operating the vehicle in any manner contrary to the manufacturer's or DISTRIBUTOR'S recommendations.

5.7 Any component failure normally prevented by immediate response to safety warning devices and signals, (e.g. overheating).

5.8 Failure resulting from defective repairs or maladjustment of engine (claim direct from repairer).

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

DISTRIBUTOR'S liability, in terms hereof, is limited to the repair or replacement of the parts covered by the warranty, and neither the manufacturers, nor DISTRIBUTOR shall be liable for any consequential damage, commercial loss or other damage of any nature whatsoever.

7. GENERAL

7.1 The Warranty shall be the only warranty, whether express or implied by law or otherwise, applicable to the vehicle.

7.2 The Warranty is in favour of the Owner only and is not transferable.

7.3 The Warranty and maintenance program shall constitute an agreement between DISTRIBUTOR and the Owner only and shall not be construed in any way as conferring any obligation upon the manufacturers or any other third party in favour of the Owner or any third party.

7.4 The Warranty is given subject to and conditional upon the Owner maintaining the vehicle strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the maintenance program.

7.5 In the event of any dispute between DISTRIBUTOR and the Owner, relating hereto, the dispute shall be referred to the manufacturers for determination, whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties.
